

SESSION 16 – JANUARY 30, 2008
Covenant and Worship
Exodus 24-25

Today we will read how God made a covenant with his people. A covenant is an agreement between 2 people, where both sides make specific promises. Let's read to see how this covenant was finalized with God and the people. Then God invited Moses to come up to Mt. Sinai and receive the stone tablets of the law. When Moses met with God, Moses received specific instructions on how God's people should worship him. The people were to make a Tabernacle, or "dwelling place," where God would live among his people. God's plans included specific furniture. We begin our study of God's tabernacle.

What was Moses to put inside the chest?

What was Moses to put on top of the cover?

God instructed Moses to build a table. What was to cover the table?

What was to stand on the table at all times?

God instructed Moses to make a lampstand. What was the lampstand to be made from?

How many arms for candles did the lampstand have?
