

**SESSION 17 – MARCH 26, 2008**  
**Review and Exodus 26 - 27**

**Welcome back to Kid's Bible Discovery!**

It is wonderful to come back together and continue our study of the book of Exodus.

Can you remember what we have read in Exodus so far?

We will read the picture book "Exodus", by Brian Wildsmith, to help us remember the story of Israel's slavery and God's plan to bring them to freedom.

Can you remember the 10 Commandments? Let's review.

Next week we will continue our study of how God instructed Moses to build a tabernacle where the people of Israel would worship God, and God would come to his people.

Why do you think God gave such exact instructions for the building of the Tabernacle?

What building do we use today that has the same function as the Tabernacle?

Do these buildings have any of the same furniture as the Tabernacle?
