

**SESSION 18 – APRIL 2, 2008**  
**Exodus 26 - 31**

**Welcome to Kid's Bible Discovery!**

Today we will continue our study of how God instructed Moses to build a tabernacle where the people of Israel would worship God, and God would come to his people. God's plans included specific furniture, and how that furniture should be used. Today we will view a computer generated picture of what the Tabernacle might have looked like.

**Chapter 26**

What were the walls of the tabernacle to be made of? Why?  
What were the frames to be made of (and covered with)?  
What was to be placed inside the Most Holy Place?  
What was to be placed in the Holy Place?

**Chapter 27**

Where was the altar of burnt offering to be placed?  
How long were the lamps to be kept burning?

**Chapter 28**

What special clothes were to be made for the priests?  
Who did God chose to be the priests?

**Chapter 29**

Let's read 29:38-46. Why did God want the people to build a Tabernacle?

**Chapter 30**

Let's read 30:11-16. How was the Tabernacle to be cared for?

**Chapter 31**

Let's read 31:12-18. What were God's specific instructions for the Sabbath?  
What did God give to Moses before Moses returned to the people of Israel at the bottom of Mt. Sinai?

**Let's look at a computer generated view of the Tabernacle.**

**Next week – Read Exodus 32-34. This is the story of the Golden Calf, a very sad chapter in the history of Israel. God is serious when God says not to have any other gods! Do we have other gods beside our God? What is most important to you?**
