Medical team with two doctors and a dentist saw patients at Penwood Medical Clinic.

Hope Valley Experimental School - Part of the construction team worked at Hope Valley each of the four work days. We poured a concrete slab 16" by 25' by the handicapped classrooms to be used for a lunch room area. Also installed 10 metal poles same area to be used to support the roof for this area. We repaired the handicapped hand rail along the sidewalk by the handicapped classroom. (Part of the railing had been broken off.) We began to repair the areas of the sidewalks that have shifted and become very uneven. Still need to finish breaking out old concrete and pour new patches. We removed old screen and replaced with new screen in the lunch room area. We painted the wall by the auditorium, the bathroom area, and the lunch room screen frames. Genora helped teach music classes and played guitar and sang with the children.

Calalloo Mews Basic School - Part of our group worked three days at Angie Simm's school. We tiled and grouted the second classroom floor. We also tiled the floor in the area that is being divided to make Angie's office and a store room. We cut out part of the wall between the classroom and the former storeroom to make a door into Angie's new office. We lowered the support for the outside edge of the canopy roof to provide better runoff of rain water. We painted walls in the one classroom. We replaced some lighting in the one classroom.
